1 Introduction

To complete your online apprenticeship enrolment application, you will need to ensure that you are logged into the <u>RICS website</u>, if you have not already created a login, please <u>register</u>.

You will then be able to access the enrolment application as follows:

- Assessment of Professional Competence (structured training) for Level 6 and Level 7 chartered surveyor degree apprenticeship.
- Associate assessment for Level 3 surveying technician apprenticeship.

As part of the online registration, we will require:

- relevant qualification details and documentation, such as proof of attendance
- · employer details and
- counsellor membership number

You will receive an email confirming that you are enrolled. If you do not receive this within ten working days, please contact the Apprentice Enrolment team (apprenticeenrolment@rics.org) with your full details including your membership number if you have this.

RICS support team – as an apprentice (also referred to as a candidate) you will have access to a <u>dedicated team of RICS staff</u>.

Important note: When you reach the Payment screen, **please do not complete payment**, as an apprentice your fees will be paid through the Apprentice Levy.

Your pathway must be one approved for the apprenticeship you are undertaking. Your training provider will be able to confirm the RICS pathway(s) they are able to offer.

Chartered surveyor degree apprenticeship (APC)

You will need to use the drop-down options. The options selected will filter based on our accredited courses database. Please ensure you select the study mode 'Degree Apprenticeship'.

You will need to upload proof of attendance. This can be existing correspondence you have from your apprentice provider confirming you are studying.

Employment

You can select pre-existing employer details that are already on our database or alternatively type new details, which will generate an email to our team to update.



Counsellor

You will need to enter your counsellor's RICS membership number. For Level 6 or 7, your counsellor must be a chartered surveyor (MRICS or FRICS). A Level 3 apprentice counsellor can also be AssocRICS, with a minimum of three years' post qualification experience.

If you do not have a counsellor or do not know their member number, you can tick the 'Counsellor Unknown' box, details requesting the counsellor's information will be sent on your enrolment email.



Declaration

Once you have agreed to the declaration and it has been accepted, you will be able to proceed to 'Next'.

If you are unable to agree to the declaration, you will be unable to finalise your application. You will be required to contact RICS Regulation (regulation@rics.org) with details as to why you were unable to accept this.



Payment

When you reach the Payment screen, **please do not complete payment**. As an apprentice, your fees will be paid through the Apprentice Levy. You can now exit the web browser.

RICS will verify your application and finalise your enrolment, you will receive a welcome email from RICS providing guidance on the next steps and your training provider will be updated. This is not an automated process, **please allow ten days** for this process to be completed.
