Expert determination fees

The expert determination fee covers RICS' administrative costs and the professional fee for undertaking the process. Each party will normally be expected to pay half of the expert determination fee. RICS will then recoup an administration fee from the expert determiner for any matter over £5,000.

£5,000 or less	£400 (£200 x 2)
£5,000 - £25,000	£1000 (£500 x 2)
£25,000 to £100,000	£2,500 (£1,250 x 2)

^{*} If a site visit is required, parties will bear any additional costs such as the expert determiner's reasonable travel costs etc. These costs (or the basis on which they will be calculated if costs are not available) will be made known to the parties and agreed prior to the site visit.
